



STEPS OF ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION

A student is admitted to Faith Baptist Academy based on the parents' desire for a Christian education for their child, as well as the child's desire to be a part of our school. To strive to maintain the integrity of our school, as well as to uphold the Biblical values and principles on which our school was founded, each potential family must go through the following registration procedures:

- 1. Interview with the principal, student(s), and parents of the potential student(s)**
- 2. Application completed and received along with the application and registration fees paid**
- 3. Copy of birth certificate**
- 4. Health form completed with all vaccinations required by the Department of Health and Human Resources**
- 5. Transfer of all academic records from previous school(s)**
- 6. Tuition contract completed and signed**
- 7. Verification of membership at a church of like faith and practice**

Upon completion of the above steps, a student is accepted on a probationary period of six weeks to ensure that they are capable of maintaining academic excellence, as well as possessing the proper attitude and Christian behavior required by all the students at FBA.

Admissions and Evaluation of Students

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

Faith Baptist Academy holds that the King James Bible is the infallible, divine Word of God and that salvation by faith in Christ is the initial step in the Christian life. There is adequate Biblical basis for the idea of spiritual growth into the image of Christ (Romans 8:29) through the work of the Holy Spirit (II Corinthians 3: 18). This growth begins at the initial moment of saving faith and continues throughout life. The Holy Spirit makes the Christian conscious of the biblical demands for a holy life which fulfills both God's moral law and high law of love (Matthew 22:37-39; Romans 13:8-10; Galatians 5:14). The result is a life consecrated unto God and separated from worldly activities.

A sense of the need for spiritual growth in our students has led Faith Baptist Academy to adopt the following standards which are based upon biblical principles and are conducive to the spiritual growth and development of young people. Students are expected to abide by the following standards throughout their enrollment, whether at home, school, or elsewhere and regardless of whether or not school is in session.

1. Maintain Christian standards of courtesy, kindness, honesty, morality, dress, and entertainment.
2. Avoid participation in worldly activities such as swearing or indecent language; inappropriate online or social media content; body piercing or tattoos; smoking in any form, including e-cigarettes and vaporizers; possession or use of alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco, or related products; involvement in the occult; gambling; stealing; dancing; pornography; premarital sex; promoting or participating in homosexual or transgender life-styles or other lifestyles contrary to Scripture; involvement in rock-style music, rap music, or so-called "Christian rock/rap" music.
3. Refrain from harassment, fighting, violence, or threats of any kind regardless of provocation; public disruptions or exhibitionism in any form; promoting division or a divisive spirit through symbols, pictures, writing, flags, banners, slogans, gang related items, or any divisive activism.

Students found to be out of compliance or harmony with Faith Baptist Academy's Standards of Conduct will be subject to administrative withdrawal. Any student who has been arrested by public law enforcement authorities will be suspended until such time as that student is adjudicated either guilty or not guilty. Any student who is adjudicated guilty will be transferred out of Faith Baptist Academy.

Faith Baptist Academy has open enrollment for students who are attending a local Baptist Church. Whether or not a student has made a personal decision to be a Christian, each student will be expected to abide by these Standards of Conduct and maintain Christian standards. Attendance at Faith Baptist Academy is a privilege, not a right.

POLICY ON PAYMENTS AND LATE PAYMENTS

The tuition paid on behalf of our students does not cover the full cost of their education. Without the support of the Faith Baptist Church, free-will gifts, and our fundraising programs, we would not be able to continue our operation. Therefore, it is vital that tuition fees be paid when due and that families participate and lend their full support to our various fundraising efforts.

1. NEW STUDENT APPLICATION & TESTING FEE

- \$50.00 (*NON-REFUNDABLE*)

2. REGISTRATION

- IF PAID BY May 15, 2025 \$100 per student
- IF PAID May 16-August 7, 2025 \$150
- IF PAID AFTER AUGUST 7, 2025 \$200

3. TUITION RATES

- \$3,950.00 FIRST CHILD
- \$3,160 (*20% discount*) EACH ADDITIONAL CHILD
- VETERANS & FULL-TIME CHRISTIAN SERVANTS GET A DISCOUNT OF 10% ON THE FIRST CHILD.
- 10% DISCOUNT IF FULL TUITION IS PAID BY AUGUST 7, 2025

4. PAYMENT DETAILS

- There are two payment options available:
 1. Tuition paid in full for a families' account will receive a 10% discount. (*Tuition only*)
 2. 10 monthly installments beginning August 10, 2025. (*Monthly payments for each student is one tenth of that year's total tuition for that student.*)
- Lump sum payments can be made at any point during the calendar year to help reduce your monthly obligation.
